General Description

Responsible for various types of aluminum weld preparation, welding and weld finishing operations to manufacture aluminum product to drawings, specifications, or other forms of instruction while working at a consistent speed with a minimum of repairs and following specific instructions in the weld out of aluminum marine vessels following project schedules and meeting established budgets.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Responsible for boat building construction to ensure conformity with applicable Rules and Coast Guard requirements
- Interface with engineers to ensure specifications are correct
- Interface with other production personnel to interpret, clarify, bring comprehension to tasks needing to be completed
- Interpretation of blueprint drawings, including weld requirement symbols
- All jobs should be performed cost effectively. Resource allocation, consumable management, and equipment care will play a large role in this practice
- Proficient in assigned aluminum welding techniques using plate, tee bar, flat bar, square tube, pipe and other extrusion with minimal rework
- Finish grinding applications using manual and hand tools
- All work areas around the yard should be kept clean on a daily and a weekly basis.
- Safe work practices should be adhered to at all times. Safety Meetings attendance is required, and the shop should be held to OSHA standards.

General Expectations

- Comprehensive ability to work from plans, specifications, drawings and blueprints. Ability to redline plans during construction is preferred
- Boat Handling and Maintenance capabilities preferred
- Ability to multi-task, organize and prioritize to meet deadlines
- Must be flexible in work hours, on call as needed
- Email viewing, composing, and sending ability preferred
